

Let's be responsible

Avoid direct contact

Saying hello can be done in different ways: Knocking your fists, your foot (shoe to shoe) or even shoulder to shoulder.

Avoid putting your fingers in your mouth, nose and eyes.

Cough or sneeze in your elbow

To avoid spreading Coronavirus through droplets, make a habit of coughing or sneezing into your elbow. Throw away your tissue quickly and rewash your hands.
